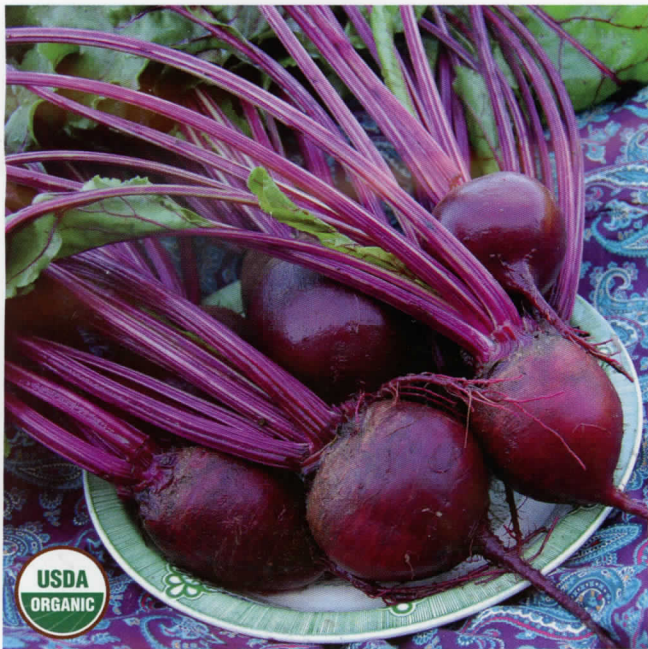




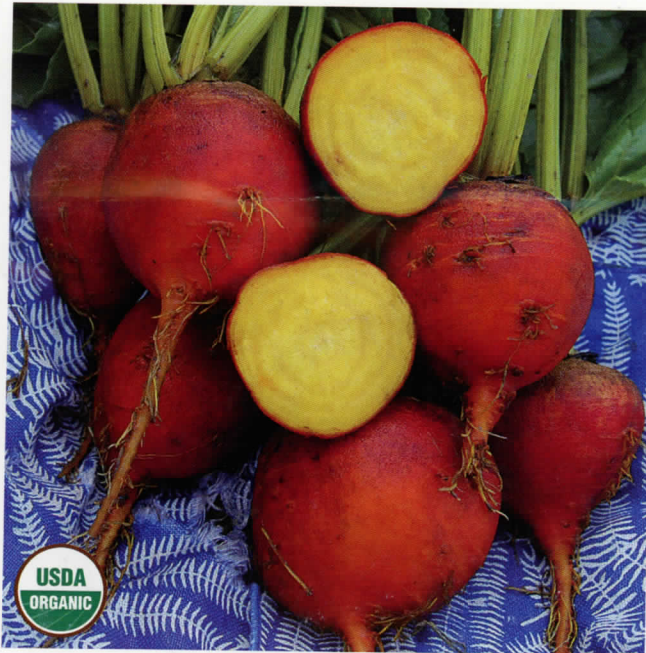

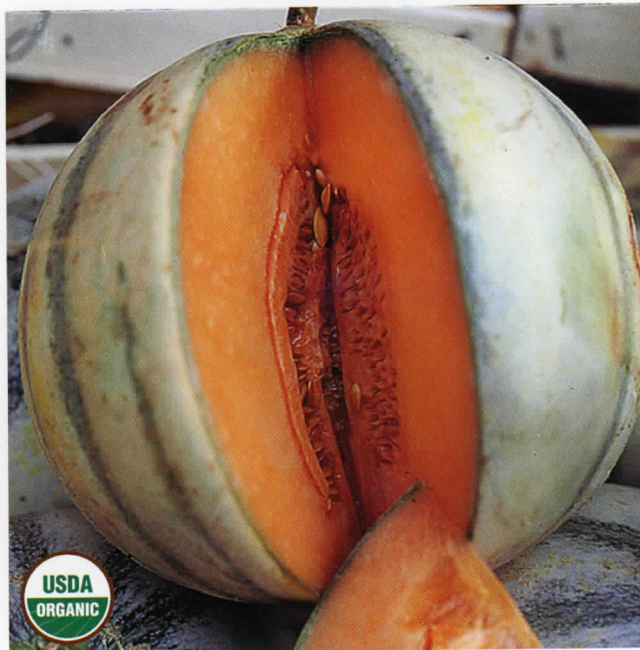

0910A - **Detroit Dark Red** (*Beta vulgaris*)

*Historic variety - Introduced to the U.S. seed trade before 1950*

Great for canning and fresh eating, this variety is a good keeper, producing round, blood-red, 3"-diameter roots. This historic variety was introduced in 1892 by D.M. Ferry & Company. Original selections were made from the Early Blood Turnip beet by Mr. Reeves of Port Hope, Ontario, Canada. 60-65 days.

**Learn To Grow It**

Direct Seed	Seed Depth	Rows Apart	Thin
2" Apart	1/2"	20-24"	4-6" Apart

**Instructions-** Sow seeds outdoors as soon as soil can be worked in spring. Seeds will germinate in 5-10 days. Plant at two-week intervals for a steady harvest. All parts of the beet plant are edible.

0611A - **Burpee's Golden** (*Beta vulgaris*)

A standout beet, offering both excellent roots and sweet, flavorful, edible greens that are ideal for sautéing. Introduced in 1970 by Burpee Seed Company, it has orange, globe-shaped roots that turn golden-yellow when cooked, are tender and mild-flavored (even when large), and will not bleed like red beets. 50-55 days.

Direct Seed	Seed Depth	Rows Apart	Thin
2" Apart	1/2"	20-24"	4-6" Apart

**Instructions-** Sow seeds outdoors as soon as soil can be worked in spring. Seeds will germinate in 5-10 days. Beets can be planted at two-week intervals for a steady harvest. All parts of the beet plant are edible.

0317 - **Spaghetti** (*Cucurbita pepo*)

This historic variety originated in Japan and was introduced to the United States by the mid-1930s by seedsmen such as Henry A. Dreer of Philadelphia. Plants bear cream-colored, cylindrical shaped fruits filled with spaghetti-like strands of delicately flavored flesh. 50-55 days.

**Learn To Grow It**

Direct Seed	Seeds to Hill	Thin	Light
1" Deep	6-8 Seeds	To 3-4 Plants	Full Sun

**Instructions-** Sow seeds outdoors in 12" diameter hills after danger of frost has passed. Hills should be spaced 6' apart in all directions. Can also be started indoors 3 weeks before transplanting out.

1206A - **Charentais** (*Cucumis melo*)

This historic melon is considered by many to be the most divine and flavorful melon in the world. The smooth round melons mature to a creamy gray with faint ribs and have sweet, juicy, orange flesh that imparts a heavenly fragrance. Typically the size of a grapefruit (and weighing 2 pounds), one fruit is perfect for two people. A true French cantaloupe that originated in the Poitou-Charentes region circa 1920. 75-90 days.

**Learn To Grow It**

Direct Seed	Seeds to Hill	Thin	Light
1" Deep	6-8 Seeds	To 3-4 Plants	Full Sun

**Instructions-** Melons love heat. Sow seeds outdoors in 12" diameter hills after danger of frost has passed and soil has warmed. Space hills 3-4' apart in all directions. Seeds will germinate in 4-10 days. Can also be started indoors 2-3 weeks before last frost.

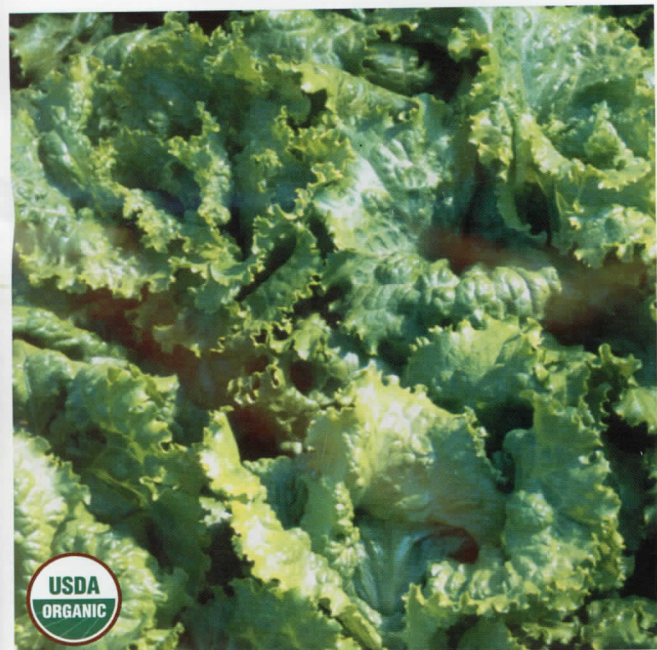

#### 0415 - Fordhook Giant (*Beta vulgaris*)

Historic variety - Introduced to the U.S. seed trade before 1950

Introduced in 1934 by W. Atlee Burpee and Co., this variety has broad, dark-green, heavily crumpled leaves with white veins and stalks. Plants grow 28" high with 2½" wide stalks and produce abundant crops all season. 50-60 days.

##### Learn To Grow It

Direct Seed	Seed Depth	Rows Apart	Thin
4" Apart	1/2"	20-24"	12" Apart

**Instructions-** Sow seeds outdoors in early spring when soil temperature is at least 50°F. Can also be started indoors 5-6 weeks before transplanting outdoors. Grows best in full sun but tolerates partial shade. Swiss chard withstands light frost.

#### 0217 - Green Oakleaf (*Lactuca sativa*)

Reportedly known as Baltimore or Philadelphia Oakleaf in the 1880s, this lettuce is now called by a more geographically neutral name and enjoyed by many. It withstands hot weather, never tastes bitter, and has an excellent quality that extends even into the late summer. Looseleaf, 50 days.

Direct Seed	Seed Depth	Germination	Thin
1" Apart	1/4"	7-14 Days	6-8" Apart

**Instructions-** Sow successively for a constant supply of lettuce. Best grown in cooler weather. Plant in full sun or partial shade.

#### 0636A - Webb's Wonderful (*Lactuca sativa*)

English lettuce that holds up well in heat. Very large and robust heads with crumpled leaves. Fine distinct flavor and good texture. Slow to bolt, holds well at market stage. Recommended for planting in the South. **Crisphead**, 65-70 days.

#### 0275A - Cilantro (*Coriandrum sativum*)

The fresh leaves of this herb, commonly known as cilantro, are used in a variety of Asian and Latin cuisines, but its seeds are also collected and used as a spice called coriander. Successive sowings of this annual herb, which bears umbels of white flowers before it sets seed, will ensure a steady supply of its edible leaves throughout the season. 50-55 days to first leaf harvest, 90-120 days for seed. Annual, 1-2' tall.

##### Learn To Grow It

Direct Seed	Germination	Thin	Light
1/2" Deep	10 Days	8-10" Apart	Sun/Partial Shade

**Instructions-** Sow seeds outdoors after last frost. May also be grown as a fall crop. Prefers rich, well-drained soil. Cilantro has a tendency to self-sow.

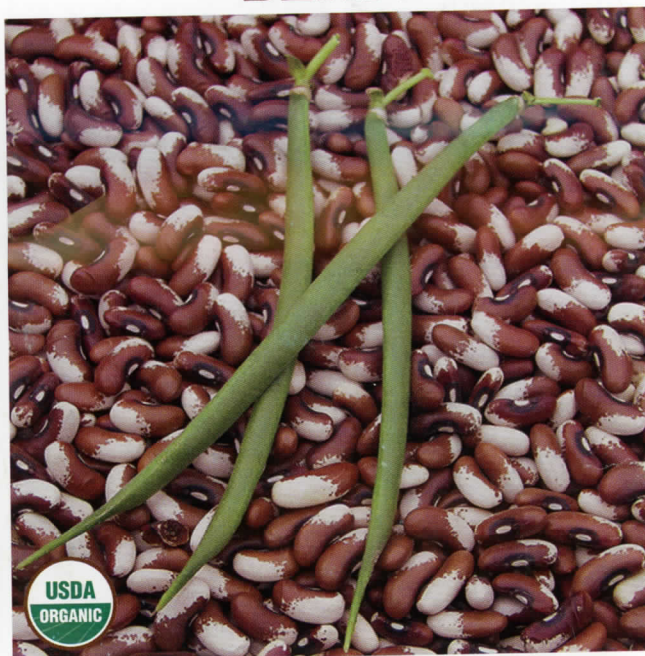

#### 1049 - Gourd Mixture (*Cucurbita pepo*)

This beautifully diverse ornamental gourd mixture contains equal portions of nine *Cucurbita pepo* varieties of different size, shape, and color: Cou-Tors Hâtive, Orange Warty, Ten Commandments, Nest Egg, Flat Striped, Striped Pear, Orange Ball, Spinning Gourd, and Warty Mixture. Ideal for use in creative fall decorations and grown in many school gardens, this mix is also a great moneymaker for market stands. 90-100 days.

#### 1202 - Apple (*Lagenaria siceraria*)

Large hard-shelled gourds shaped like an apple. Mottled green skin dries to brown; very long shelf life. Gourds are 6-8" tall and 4-6" across. Best used for crafting and birdhouses. 100-120 days.

##### Learn To Grow It

Direct Seed	Seeds to Hill	Thin	Light
1" Deep	6-8 Seeds	To 3-4 Plants	Full Sun

**Instructions-** Sow seeds outdoors after the danger of frost has passed in 12" diameter hills. Space hills 6' apart in all directions. In short-season areas, grow from transplants started indoors 8 weeks in advance. Gourds grow well on fences or garden trellises.

#### 1486 - Pencil Pod Golden Wax (*Phaseolus vulgaris*)

*Historic variety - Introduced to the U.S. seed trade before 1950*

This old-time favorite, introduced in 1900, is regaled for its quality and delicious wax bean flavor. The stringless pods reach 5-7" long on heavy-producing plants that grow 15-20" tall. Ideal for freezing or canning. Bush habit, wax, 50-65 days.

##### Learn To Grow It

Direct Seed	Seed Depth	Rows Apart	Light
2" Apart	1"	36-48"	Full Sun

**Instructions-** Sow seeds outdoors after danger of frost has passed and soil and air temperatures have warmed. Harvest frequently for increased yields.

#### 1462A - Painted Pony (*Phaseolus vulgaris*)

Enjoy this very productive, dual-purpose bean fresh or dried. The long, thin pods are stringless and good for eating as snap beans if picked young. If allowed to mature, the dry beans are excellent for soups and retain their markings when cooked. Bush habit, 60 days for snaps, 80 days for dry beans.

##### Learn To Grow It

Direct Seed	Seed Depth	Support	Light
2" Apart	1"	Trellis, tepee or fencing	Full Sun

**Instructions-** Sow seeds outdoors after danger of frost has passed and soil and air temperatures have warmed. Harvest snap beans frequently for increased yields. Leave some pods on the vine and harvest when completely mature for dry beans.

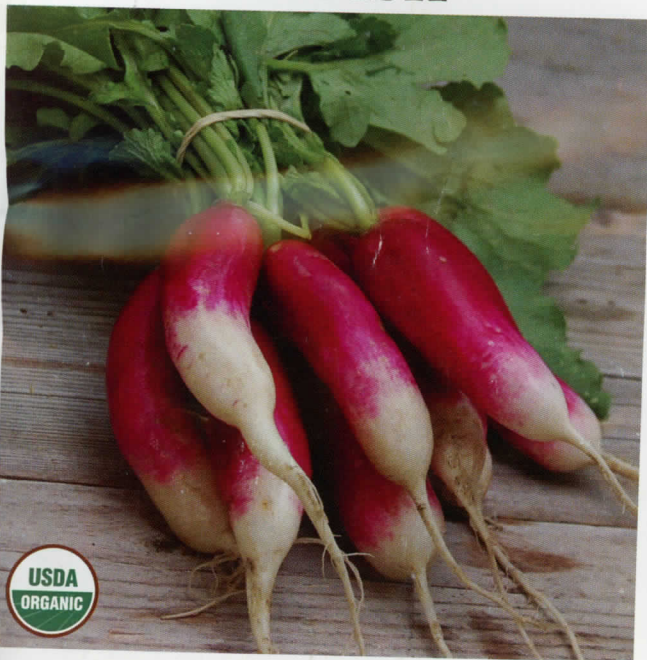

#### 0148A - Parris Island Cos (*Lactuca sativa*)

The slightly ruffled leaves of this romaine variety are crunchy and sweet at any size, making it a standout for salads, lettuce wraps, and baby greens. Plants with buttery-green hearts grow upright to 10-12" tall, resist tipburn, and are mosaic virus tolerant. Leaves can be harvested at any size. Developed by Clemson University and the USDA, it is named for Parris Island, South Carolina. **Romaine**, 65 days.

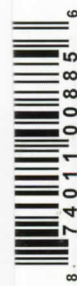

#### 1575A - Little Potato (*Cucumis sativus*)

(aka Khira Balam) Originally from India. Introduced into the 1997 SSE Yearbook by Indiana member Robert F. Bruns who got his seed from the USDA. Nearly round 3" fruits with brown russeted skin are borne heavily on robust semi-bush plants. Delicious lemon flavor. Stays crisp in storage. 70 days.

##### Learn To Grow It

Direct Seed	Seeds to Hill	Thin	Light
1" Deep	6-8 Seeds	To 3-4 Plants	Full Sun

**Instructions-** Sow seeds outdoors in 12" diameter hills after the last frost when soil is warm. Space hills 6' apart in all directions. Can also be started indoors 2-4 weeks before the last frost for an earlier harvest. Cucumbers benefit from consistent moisture. Provide support for vines to save space.

#### 0420A - French Breakfast (*Raphanus sativus*)

*Historic variety - Introduced to the U.S. seed trade before 1950*

Also known as Radis Demi-long Rose a Bout Blanc, these very showy, rose-scarlet radishes are oblong and blunt at the white tip. Often seen bunched together and displayed at summer markets, they have white, crisp flesh with a mildly pungent flavor and a little bit of a bite for an early radish. Sow in the spring or fall and pick when small. Of French origin. Listed by J.M. Thorburn & Company of New York in 1870. 20-30 days.

Direct Seed	Seed Depth	Rows Apart	Thin
1" Apart	1/2"	12"	2-3" Apart

**Instructions-** Sow seeds outdoors as soon as soil can be worked in spring. Plant in full sun. Sow every 3-4 weeks to provide a continual harvest.
